Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

THE DISTRICT

Chowchilla Union High School District comprises a comprehensive four-year academic high school, Chowchilla Union High School; a continuation school, Gateway Continuation School; and an Independent Study program. Alview-Dairyland Union School District and Chowchilla Elementary School District, both K-8 districts, feed students into Chowchilla UHSD.

The history of Chowchilla Union High School began with its opening in September 1916 to fourteen students enrolled in first and second year courses. Today Chowchilla Union High School District

educates approximately 1,113 students in grades nine through twelve. There are approximately 30 students served in the independent study program. Gateway Continuation School provides students with an alternative setting from the traditional high school system.

Chowchilla has families that range from economically wealthy to very poor. Student free and reduced lunches have averaged 67.2% of the student population over the last six years.

Members of the community take great pride in their small-town school districts and work together to support one another, always striving to be best by the students, staff, and their families.

THE COMMUNITY

Chowchilla is located in the heart of California's Central Valley at the junction of two major tourist and commercial transportation routes. Chowchilla is located 15 miles northwest of Madera, CA, and has a population of 18,533. Chowchilla has direct highway links to many of the premier California destinations such as Yosemite National Park, Kings Canyon National Park, Monterey and the Pacific Ocean, Sacramento and the State Capital, San Jose and Silicon Valley, and the Napa Wine Country.

Chowchilla's central location, potential for positive economic growth and ideal climate make it a target town for new innovations. Ideal for new businesses but more importantly, a stable and clean environment for employee families to live and raise children.

A challenging and enjoyable educational system is present as well as safe intramural activities that make Chowchilla a great place to become an active community member. The town has immense economic potential for new, diverse businesses yet maintains a safe, clean and supportive environment for all community members.
