#### THE COMMUNITY

Enterprise Elementary School District is in arguably the most beautiful area in America. Outdoor recreational activities are plentiful in and around the area!

Redding is a city of nearly 100,000, and the crystal-clear Sacramento River flows through the town. The Sundial Bridge and Turtle Bay Exploration Park are not to be missed. The bridge, part of an extensive river trail system, is a cantilever spar cable-stayed, glass-bottom bridge for bicycles and pedestrians that spans the Sacramento River. The structure forms a large sundial, casting its shadow on time markers below. Whiskeytown Lake offers stunning scenery, picnic facilities, camping, and opportunities for water activities. The Schreder Planetarium offers a variety of shows and programs, and about an hour away is the Hat Creek Radio Observatory, home of the Allen Telescope Array consisting of 350, 20-foot telescopes! Take a seven-mile drive north, and you will come upon Shasta Lake and Shasta Dam. Breathtaking views and guided tours are available at the dam, and water activities are readily available. An hour to the north lies Mt. Shasta where snow is available most of the year. To the east is Mt. Lassen Volcanic National Park, a multifaceted gem with opportunities for hiking, climbing, camping among the lava beds, geologic formations, and waterfalls. Between Mt. Shasta and Mt. Lassen lies Burney Falls, often called the Eighth Wonder of the World.
