THE POSITION

The Director of Special Services provides leadership in all aspects of the District's student support programs, assists and works independently in formulating and implementing district policies for the Oro Grande School District and its authorized Charters including but not limited to District Intervention Systems, Crisis Management, Special Education Services, Legal Compliance and Reporting, Mental Health & Wellness, Health Services, Student Discipline and Safety, Student Attendance, and Parent Education.

PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

The Oro Grande School District seeks an Executive Director who:

- Will provide a clear vision, leadership and support to the Oro Grande School District and its authorized Charters as it relates to Special Services.
- Has experience in organization and oversight of special services including school and student safety, Special Education, wellness and mental health services, health services, mental health services, student discipline and prevention services, homeless and foster care youth, student attendance and welfare, crisis management, disaster preparedness as it relates to student safety.
- Will provide Professional Development to the Oro Grande School District and its authorized Charters as it relates to Special Services.
- Will serve as representative for the District to multiple SELPAS.
- Has a deep knowledge and understanding of special education laws, regulations, and due process.
- Has leadership experience in special education. General education and site level experience, desirable
- Has a good understanding of special education funding.
- Is highly knowledgeable in the area instructional leadership.
- Has the ability and background to address the issues associated with a growing special education population.

- Experience with charter school education, alternative education, special education, and student services

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultants Dr. Dennis Smith and Rich Thome of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Superintendent for interviews and further consideration. The Superintendent and Cabinet will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with the Superintendent or Board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. The Superintendent and Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

Less than 1,000 residents live in the unincorporated area. Neighboring townships include Silver Lakes, Helendale, Adelanto and Victorville.
