SELECTION PROCESS

The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

THE DISTRICT

The Williams School District has a proud heritage stretching back to the early 1900's. A great number of Williams residents are graduates of Williams High School, as are their parents and grandparents. Each of the five school board members are Williams high school graduates, as are a significant number of employees.

The District has a TK-12 enrollment of approximately 1,345 students. Demographically, it has two major student groups, 94.9% Hispanic and 2.8% White with 3% Other. The LEA serves students through a TK3 Elementary (465 ADA), a 46 Upper Elementary (332 ADA), a 712 Jr./Sr. High School (600 ADA) and a 712 Continuation High School (22 ADA). The schools are located in a 48-acre plot of land, next to each other, located north west from the center of town. Close to 47.8% of our students are English Language Learners with 1/3 of these students being Migrant students and about 135 of them living in a Migrant Camp, which is considered substandard housing, qualifying students for McKinney Vento. Williams USD serves its students through Local Control Funding Formula monies and other grant funding sources which provide various services focused on instruction, learning and social emotional well being of all students

THE COMMUNITY

The city of Williams, with a population of approximately 5,123, is located off the Interstate -5 and Highway 20 corridors, one hour north of Sacramento. It is perfectly located for those who seek a quieter lifestyle with easy access to outdoor activities and cultural events. It's a rural agricultural community with rice and tomatoes being among the major products grown. Demographically, it is 76% Hispanic/Latino and 20% White
