The Newport-Mesa Unified School District seeks a superintendent who:

- Has been a classroom teacher, principal and executive cabinet leader, superintendent experience desirable
- Understands and values the culture of our district and community
- Provides consistent and focused communication
- Involves others in decision making, takes input and is responsive to the thinking of others
- Has experience working in a comparable school district with similar demographics
- Has experience working with a diverse student and parent population
- Has demonstrated the ability to work collaboratively and effectively with the Board of Education
- Has a good understanding of K-12 budgets, state finances and basic-aid funding
- Has successful experience building the capacity of all staff
- Has successful experiences working collaboratively with labor groups
- Has demonstrated the ability to successfully work with and through others in establishing and implementing a clear district-wide vision
- Has a track record of success in building strong, consistent and coherent district-wide systems
- Will build partnerships with cities, businesses and community support organizations
