The Board of Education of the South Bay Union School District invites highly qualified educational leaders to apply for the position of District Superintendent. The Board welcomes a diverse group of candidates.

PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

The South Bay Union School District seeks a superintendent who:

- Has a proven track record of growing academic achievement for ALL students
- Has been a classroom teacher, principal and executive level leader, superintendent experience desirable
- Is culturally proficient with respect to the demographic make-up of SBUSD students, families, employees and community.
- Has experience advocating for students, employees, and community at various levels of society e.g., grassroot efforts, government, and civil-society groups.
- Has experience working with employees and union groups in an open, transparent, honest, and forward-thinking manner.
- Has experience in research regarding best practices for Bilingual Emerging students, students with disabilities, ethnic studies, and students that are low-income.
- Will engage the community in a multi-dimensional way e.g. online resources, community meetings, mailers, radio commercials, and face-to-face engagements.
- Has a political and social understanding of what it means to be a "border district."
- Has successfully guided equity work at an executive level
- Has demonstrated the ability to work collaboratively with the Board of Education, teachers, staff, parents, students and the community
- Has a good understanding of K-8 budgets and state finances, including special education
- Has a good understanding of the social, emotional and academic issues affecting students
- Has a strong focus on the needs of English Language Learners and the need for strong parent involvement of parents of ELL students
- Has a track record of holding self and others accountable

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultants Mr. Rich Thome and Dr. Dennis Smith of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

THE DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

The South Bay Union School District is the most south-westerly school district in the United States. It is located in San Diego County and serves a diverse population of Pre-Kindergarten - 8th grade students in Imperial Beach, San Ysidro, and south San Diego. The District, which covers a region of 14.38 square miles of land area and 2.29 square miles of water area, has a student enrollment of approximately 6.019, (including over 500 Preschool students). South Bay Union has a total of 12 schools, including two dependent Charter Schools and one Preschool, and employs 950 staff members.

South Bay is dedicated to the success of each and every student by providing an innovative learning environment with exceptional teachers dedicated to creating a challenging and supportive classroom. SBUSD has 1:1 devices connected to the Internet with access to high quality educational software programs in all classrooms in grades 3-8; and 3:1 devices, with the same access, available in TK-2 classrooms. Middle school students have the opportunity to take their device home and engage in learning 24/7. SBUSD strives to have students engage with technology every day to extend their opportunity to learn, create, collaborate, and share.

In addition to having relevant technology accessible to every student, South Bay offers a variety of specialized programs including Visual and Performing Arts, a STEAM Academy, Instrumental Music, Dual Immersion and Biliteracy, Leader in Me Program, No Excuses University, and a Virtual Academy School. In addition to core subjects, our schools offer enrichment activities including art, robotics, business, coding, debate, intramural sports, and more.
