SELECTION PROCESS

The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

Located in Southwest Riverside County, the Lake Elsinore Unified School District covers more than 144 square miles and serves TK-12 students from the cities of Lake Elsinore, Canyon Lake and Wildomar, and several unincorporated Riverside County communities, including Lakeland Village and Horsethief Canyon.

The district operates 24 schools, as well as alternative education programs. Approximately 21,565 students, grades TK-12, are served by approximately 2, 424 employees throughout the District.

The AVID program is offered at many of our elementary, middle, and high schools; three schools have earned the distinction of AVID National Demonstration Schools: Terra Cotta Middle School, Elsinore High School, and Lakeside High School.
