Our Schools: San Luis Coastal's schools include 10 elementary, 2 middle, 2 comprehensive high schools, and 1 continuation high school. Maintaining small schools reflects our educational philosophy of knowing students on a very personal level. Our success as a district is reflected by numerous California Distinguished School Awards, National Blue Ribbon Awards, and many other honors. Our schools are dynamic, student-centered learning communities where all children are expected to take risks, explore new opportunities, and discover their unique potential.

Our Belief: We believe that every child matters regardless of their circumstances. Through the three "Rs" of rigor, relevance, and relationship, students are provided valuable opportunities to become the very best they can be. "Success for All" requires many hands, multiple networks of thoughtful people, and an expectation that every child can achieve to their fullest. This is our conscious journey as a school district.

Dual Immersion Program

Pacheco School has a 90/10 Two Way Immersion Program offering the San Luis Coastal Unified elementary students the unique opportunity to acquire literacy in two languages, English and Spanish. This is an additive bilingual program in that students will acquire a second language, but will not be at risk of losing their first language, as they often do in traditional bilingual programs.

Two Way Immersion programs bring two languages and their respective native speakers together in all academic and social aspects of the school day. By being immersed daily in the practical use of the two languages, students develop literacy and fluency in both languages.

The academic focus of the program is centered on our existing board adopted K-6 curriculum and California content standards. 90% of instruction in kindergarten is in Spanish and 10% in English. This ratio changes over the years to eventually become 50%/50% in 4-6 grades.

Pacheco School is a wonderful mix of language, culture, challenging standards, arts, music, and a balanced program. Everyone who attends or works at Pacheco School is here by choice, and that creates a unique sense of community and purpose of which we are very proud.

The majority of the staff including teachers, aides, clerical, counseling and principal are fully bilingual. This helps connect our families with their school community and their child's teachers.

The program requires extensive collaboration and teaming of teachers in each grade level. It is a vibrant professional teaching culture.

Pacheco's program is a long standing and highly successful program, 22 years in existence in 2018. The entire school is TWI and the program is highly supported by our district, superintendent and board of education.

The program features an extended day Kindergarten program and a 90/10 preschool program.

The program requires continued staff development in Lucy Calkins Reading and Writing Units of Study. Thematic Integrated Instruction, and Cooperative Learning through the Guided Language Acquisition Design (GLAD) Program. Teams of teachers attend CABE annually for professional development.
