SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Dr. Blanca G. Cavazos and Dr. Marc Ecker of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision. Please note: As part of the selection process, finalists will interview with the Board of Education and a Community Advisory Panel.

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

THE DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

Originally established by City Charter in 1861, the San Rafael City Schools has for generations understood the importance of providing a safe, challenging and culturally rich learning environment that provides our students with the opportunity to realize their maximum potential and prepare for the challenges ahead.

Today, the San Rafael City Schools is comprised of twelve schools that serve approximately 7,000 students. In accordance with the City Charter, the San Rafael City Schools represents two separate school districts: one for elementary grades (K-8) and one for the high school level (9-12). Both Districts are governed by one five-member Board of Education and share a Superintendent. The Elementary District is composed of nine schools. The High School District provides secondary education to students residing in two elementary districts: Miller Creek Elementary District and San Rafael Elementary District. The High School District has two comprehensive 9-12 high schools and a continuation high school.

The San Rafael City Schools (SRCS) community ensures that every student receives an empowering education. High expectations and skillful individualized instruction enable each student to embrace their own learning, think critically and experience success. Our welcoming school climate ensures that our diverse community of students, families, staff and community members are treated with dignity and respect, creating opportunities for participation, engagement and support. Every student graduates college and/or career ready, able to take responsibility for a future that includes life-long learning.

THE COMMUNITY

San Rafael is the oldest, largest and most culturally diverse city in Marin and also enjoys the best weather. San Rafael is a lively business and cultural center located in an area of incomparable natural beauty. At the city's heart is its charming, vibrant downtown shopping district with a mixture of Victorian buildings, ethnic restaurants, retail stores and financial institutions. In July 2017, the California Arts Council selected San Rafael as one of California's premier state-designated arts and culture districts. The San Rafael community enjoys seasonal events such as the Thursday night farmers markets and summertime concerts and offers many sites to visit and activities. These include the nearby authentic recreation of Mission San Rafael Arcangel; founded in 1817 as part of California's mission chain; many beautifully restored turn-of-the century buildings, including.

the Falkirk Cultural Center and the 106-year-old Dominican University; and the Marin County Civic Center, home to the county's government offices and an architectural treasure designed by architect Frank Lloyd Wright. Parklands and open space account for nearly 30 percent of the city's land. Since it borders the San Pablo Bay, San Rafael has an abundance of marinas and many water-oriented recreational activities are available. Nature lovers will appreciate the quiet beauty of China Camp State Park, a 1,600-acre park with hiking and biking trails and overnight campsites.
