The Board of Education of the Brisbane School District invites highly qualified educational leaders to apply for the position of District Superintendent. The Board welcomes a diverse group of candidates.

#### **SELECTION PROCESS**

The Board of Education has retained Consultant Dr. Jacki Horejs of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultant will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

#### **SALARY AND CONTRACT**

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. This approximate salary range is \$190,000 - \$240,000.

To be considered, the candidate must provide:

- A letter of introduction
- A fully completed application form
- A resume
- Three current letters of recommendation (within the past twelve months)
- Verification of degrees and credentials (finalists only)

#### THE DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

The Brisbane School District is located in the northern section of San Mateo County and includes Brisbane and parts of Daly City and South San Francisco. The District is comprised of three schools: Brisbane Elementary School (est. 1936), Lipman Middle School (est. 1956), and the Panorama Elementary School (est. 1963.) Each has a full-time principal on site and has been recently modernized.

In 2022-23, we served 489 total students in two TK-5 schools and one 6--8 campus. Our student body is diverse: 28.6% of our students have a first language that is not English (18 world languages; 10.4% total English Learners, i.e., not English proficient), and 6% were not born in the USA (15 other countries). Nearly one-quarter of our student body is considered high need (what used to be termed the "unduplicated pupils"). The high-need student group includes the 10.4% English learners and 19.2% socio-economically disadvantaged youth. Serving this student body is 4 administrators, 5 pupil services professionals, 35 certificated teachers, 19 instructional aides/paraprofessionals, 11 classified support professionals (school secretaries, library clerks, district staff), and 5 custodian/groundskeepers.

The Brisbane School District graduates students who are thoughtful, prepared, and engaged citizens. Our program emphasizes conceptual understanding, teaching the Common Core State Standards through year-long themes. With an emphasis on higher-order thinking skills, we focus on understanding, evaluating, and creating. We thread Lifeskills throughout our curriculum with the goal of providing our children the tools for citizenship and life. We further believe that children learn best by constructing meaning from their experiences, so strive to give them ample opportunities to explore both in and outside of their classrooms.

The Brisbane School District enjoys an active PTO (BEST-PTO) and a volunteer base of over 189 dedicated individuals. Our reciprocal partnerships with the City of Daly City, the City of Brisbane, the Brisbane Chamber of Commerce, and the Brisbane Lions Club allow us to provide programs and facilities to our students and families beyond the classroom.
