The Trona Joint Unified School District seeks a superintendent who:

- Has experience as an administrator, preferably a superintendent
- Has strong knowledge of the budget and business management
- Is knowledgeable in negotiations and collective bargaining
- Will be able to write grants to bring revenue to Trona
- Will make sure that teachers and staff know the policies, regulations and changing laws
- Has expertise in special education
- Will always put students first and has a track record of growing academic achievement for students
- Has experience in California
- Has worked with low-income and transient families
- Is a leader with strong human relations skills
- Is a leader who wants to communicate frequently with teachers and staff
- Will be able to communicate well with parents and get them involved
- Is a team builder, able to create a cohesive team and is open to teacher opinion
- Is accessible with a collaborative leadership style
- Has the ability to work in a small school district and wear many hats
- Knows that with difficulty finding teachers, he/she may need to do substitute teaching

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultant Richard Thome Chavez of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultant will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a

breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

THE DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

The Trona Joint Unified School District (TJUSD) is a small, rural school district in the upper Northwest corner of San Bernardino County. The geographic border encompasses two Southern California counties (San Bernardino and Inyo) and covers nearly 1,600 square miles. The small unincorporated town of Trona has nearly 2,000 residents. Trona High School and Trona Elementary School have approximately 270 students in Transitional Kindergarten through 12th grade. The main industry in town is Searles Valley Minerals Incorporated. The current company is an extension of a series of companies that have been in operation for over 100 years in Searles Valley. As the number of employees decreased, so did the number of students in Trona schools. Trona Joint Unified School District is the second largest employer in town. Many of the current residents of Trona have attended Trona schools. There is a strong sense of pride for Trona schools in the community.
