- Will provide effective oversight of our district's financial, business and operations
- Has a track record of success in providing the academic achievement and social/emotional support systems to help our students and staff reach their full potential
- Is capable of building a strong and successful district wide culture of teamwork, trust, openness, and honesty
- Has experience establishing systems and strategies to make decisive decisions, problem solve, and effectively collaborate with all stakeholders in that process
- Has a track record of demonstrating strong and effective communication skills (writing, listening, and speaking)
- Has demonstrated the ability to work collaboratively and effectively with the Board of Education

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultants Jacki Horejs, Ed.D. and David Verdugo, Ed.D. of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. This approximate range is \$175,000 - \$215,000.

THE DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

Live Oak is a diverse community located in the heart of Santa Cruz County. It spans a 3.2 square mile area bordering Monterey Bay Coast and Highway 1.

Live Oak School District was established in 1872 and currently serves approximately 1,500 students in three elementary schools, one middle school, one K-8 independent charter school, and one alternative school. The student population is 50% Hispanic, 31% White, 19% Other, 30% English learner, and 60% Socioeconomically disadvantaged.

All three comprehensive elementary schools are California Gold Ribbon Schools for literacy. Live Oak Elementary School, Shoreline Middle School, and Tierra Pacifica Charter School were each named a California Distinguished School by the California Department of Education. In 2023, "California Schools to Watch" selected Shoreline Middle School as a middle school that is academically excellent, developmentally responsive, socially equitable, and has a culture of collaborative leadership.
