- Is consistent in dealing with groups and individuals

SELECTION PROCESS

The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

THE DISTRICT

Sierra Unified School District (SUSD), located in the eastern Fresno County foothills serves over 1,300 students in grades TK-12. Sierra Unified is a rural school district located approximately 35 miles northeast of Fresno and covers a region of approximately 2,000 square miles. Within the District boundaries lie three Native American Rancherias with direct ancestral ties to the Native American Mono Tribe. Included are Table Mountain Rancheria, Big Sandy Rancheria and Cold Springs Rancheria, each with their own rich, cultural heritage.

Some of Sierra's greatest features include a 200-acre school farm, an extended learning program for students K-12, dual enrollment offerings and an MTSS-structure that addresses student's social emotional health as well as their academic performance.

Sierra Unified has three campuses and two online school options to meet the educational needs of district families. These include; Foothill Elementary School (TK-6), Sierra Junior High School (7-8), Sierra High School (9-12). Additionally, the Alternative Education Center provides opportunities at Sierra Alternative High School (9-12), Sierra@Home Elementary (K-5), Sierra@Home Secondary (6-12) and Black Mountain Adult School.

The Sierra@Home schools offer parent-choice for an online platform of education and instruction. Sierra Junior and Senior High Schools share facilities, administration and many staff members to serve the 7-12 grade population. In 2020-2021, WASC accreditation was awarded to Sierra High School, Sierra Alternative High School, Black Mountain Adult School and Sierra@Home.

The District's student enrollment in the 2020-2021 school year included: 60.9% White, 18.7% Hispanic, 14.4% American Indian and 5.6% other. The student population includes 86.89% Socioeconomically Disadvantaged, this number reflects a significant increase as a result of temporary and long-term displacement due to the Creek Fire in September 2020. 13.9% Students with Disabilities, 0.91% English Learners and 17.35% Homeless and Foster Youth.

The vision of Sierra Unified is to be an exemplary student-focused school district that is highly regarded for the competence and character of our students, the rich connection to our mountain community, and the excellence of our people, programs and learning environment. The achievement of this vision is facilitated by the district's mission to inspire, engage, challenge, and support all students to reach their highest level of learning and personal development.

THE COMMUNITY

Sierra Unified School District is located in a beautiful valley between the Fresno County foothill communities of Tollhouse, Prather and Auberry, approximately 35 miles from downtown Fresno with access by way of Highway 168 or rural Auberry Road. Business and industry is largely made up of public utilities, the U.S. Forest Service, the state division of forestry, logging, ranching and outdoor recreation. Many outdoor enthusiasts reside in the district while even more come up off the valley floor to rest and play in the mountains. The rural nature of this community has historically put the schools at the center of the community much like a hub of socialization at school music and drama productions, athletic events and hosting community youth groups and athletic leagues or the local Craft Fair. It is not uncommon for our campuses to be busy with activity 6-7 days a week.
