The Hughes-Elizabeth Lakes Union Elementary School District seeks a superintendent/principal who:

- Possesses district-level and principal experience, preferably in a small district setting
- Has experience with effective governance and board relations and is willing to participate in Board governance training
- Is knowledgeable of budget management, fiscal oversight, district operations and alternative funding
- Has a background in human resources, personnel regulations, and union negotiations
- Demonstrates data-driven decision-making and strategic planning to support district improvement
- Is skilled in effectively delegating tasks while maintaining accountability and oversight
- Is a successful instructional leader with knowledge of best practices, teaching strategies, and curriculum development
- Is a visible presence on campus and in the community, actively engaging with students, staff, families and community members
- Is proactive in safety planning, such as crisis management strategies, security protocols and safety drills
- Is skilled in effectively communicating and collaborating with all education partners

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultant Dr. Blanca Cavazos of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultant will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. The salary range is \$156,000 - \$172,000; based on experience.
