The Gonzales Unified School District seeks a superintendent who:

- Has a broad educational background including experience as a secondary school administrator and Cabinet member

- Has experience working in a small district with a similar demographic
- Has a proven track record of improving student achievement and educational outcomes for all students
- Has experience managing budgets, especially in a smaller district facing financial constraints
- Is visible and actively involved in school and the community
- Is a proven leader who fosters a collaborative, team-oriented work culture
- Is a problem solver and creative in overcoming challenges
- Values input from staff, students, community, and parents before making key decisions
- Has a clear vision for the district's future and the ability to develop a shared vision with educational partners
- Is culturally competent and equity focused
- Is accountable

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultant Jacki Horejs, Ed.D. of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultant will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. The approximate salary range is \$225,000 - \$260,000

- Three current letters of recommendation (within the past twelve months)
- Verification of degrees and credentials (finalists only)

THE DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

Gonzales is a small, rural, and predominantly agricultural community located in the Salinas Valley. Gonzales Unified School District (GUSD) is the only school district in the community, serving approximately 2,110 students from Transitional Kindergarten to 12th grade. GUSD operates three comprehensive schools and one adult school including La Gloria Elementary School for students from TK to 5th, Fairview Middle School for students from 6th to 8th, and Gonzales High School for students from 9th to 12th grade. The Gonzales students represent 98% of Hispanic or Latino descent, and out of these students, 45% are classified as English Language Learners. Of the total student population, 88% are identified as low socio-economic, 15% as Homeless/Foster, and 13% are students with disabilities.

The Gonzales Unified School District is committed to providing a quality education that prepares all students to be lifelong learners in order to empower students to become successful and contributing members of society. In order to realize our vision, GUSD's mission is to provide high-quality and meaningful educational experiences that will prepare our students for post-secondary college and career success and encourage them to become life-long learners.
